Why This Matters:


More than two-thirds of risk incidents have a quality and safety impact. By proactively identifying these incidents, hospitals gain more complete visibility, improve compliance, and can take earlier action to reduce adverse events, liability, and financial penalties.

Platform Goals & Objectives:

- 1) Identify under reported risk & incidents.
- 2) Connect risk incidents to quality and safety activities.
- 3) Reduce manual reporting burden. Minimize compliance and financial exposure.
